ABOUT THE BEGINNING COLLEGE SURVEY OF STUDENT ENGAGEMENT (BCSSE)

The purpose of the BCSSE is to measure entering first-year students' pre-college academic and co-curricular experiences and attitudes and expectations for their first year of college.

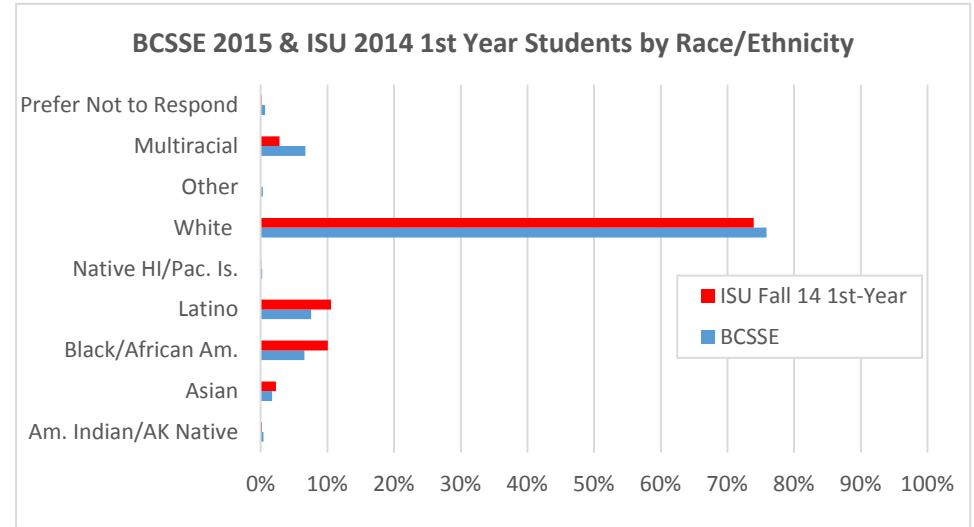
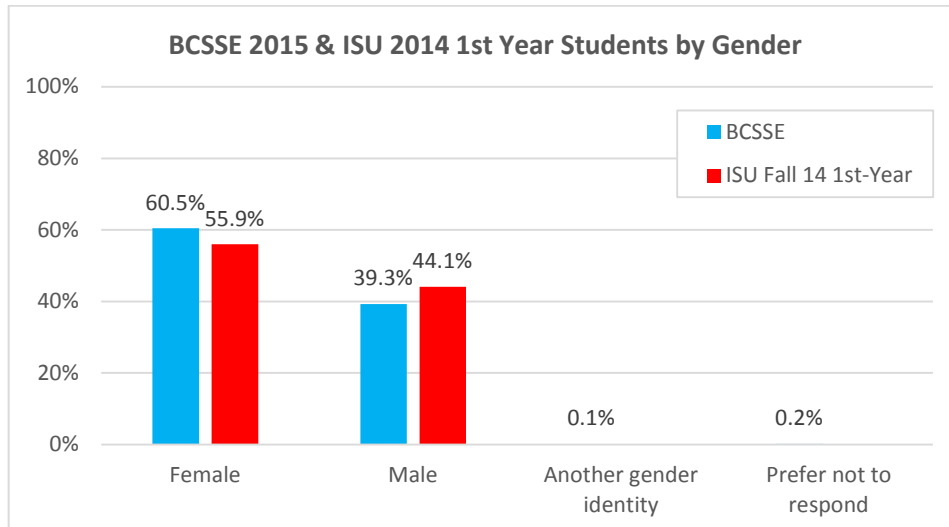

HIGH SCHOOL BACKGROUND INFORMATION FROM BCSSE

- 63% report taking at least one AP course in high school.
- 45% took at least one college-level course in high school.
- Over 90% earned at least a “C” in Algebra II.
- 60% report being first-generation.
- 30% report never working for pay during their senior year.
- Student involvement (very much or quite a bit):
 - Athletics: 59%
 - Community Service: 40%
 - Academic/Honor clubs: 29%
 - Performing or visual arts: 28%
 - Religious: 12%
 - Student Govt.: 11%
 - Vocational: 9%
 - Student publications: 8%

2015 ADMINISTRATION INFORMATION

2,251 surveys completed. Surveys administered to incoming first-year students at ISU during Preview in summer 2015.

98% graduated high school in 2015.

Students who completed the summer 2015 BCSSE will have the opportunity to complete the NSSE in spring 2016 and 2019, as the fifth engagement survey cohort (see the table on reverse side of this document).
