#### **Engagement**

Engagement is the degree to which a student invests time and motivation in their college experience. **Engagement is** associated with student success. The NSSE measures student engagement in a variety of areas. The NSSE takes an asset-based approach to measuring engagement in that it focuses on student perspectives about what ISU can do to help them be successful.

### **Dimensions of engagement**

**Behavioral engagement** refers to what students do. This includes their investment of time, energy and resources to college-related activities and experiences.

Emotional engagement refers to positive or negative affective responses to college experiences.

Cognitive engagement is about the time, energy and resources directed towards complex concepts and acquisition of skills.


### Civic Engagement

Percent engaged in community service or volunteer work








### Of the time you spend preparing for class in a typical 7-day week, about how much is on assigned reading?









Estimated average number of hours per week working for pay OFF campus






#### During the current school year, to what extent have your courses challenged you to do your best work?


